2. Apologies

5. Minutes of meeting held May 2023

6. Matters arising

- The issue with water at the foot of N Campbell Road was awaiting parts so it could be fixed.
- Gill had asked for the fact that the caravan at the site of The Cube at the top of Royal Brae had now been occupied for more than a month, with no sewage nor water supply. Alan confirmed this had been raised with the planners.

7. Treasurer's report

None but little will have changed since the accounts agreed at the AGM.

8. Planning

Given the comments made by SCCC members about the proposal for 2 linked properties in the field adjacent to Inverchoalain Church, Alan confirmed an objection had been made on behalf of SCCC. There was discussion about other planning matters which were noted.

9. Roads & Amenity Services

Reference was made to the outstanding issues mentioned in the convener's AGM report. Councillors were awaiting a meeting with the council public transport officer about the 489 service.

10. The Lido

There was a general discussion about concerns that had been raised about The Lido and it was agreed that it was essential that the shop continued in operation. It was also agreed that Michael would raise the issues related to the 2022 accounts with the SCCE treasurer.

11. AOCB

- The stones laid across the lay byes on the shore side opposite Castle Toward land had been removed by the roads department.
- The picnic bench at the green needed to be replaced. It was agreed to consider this at the August meeting once quotes had been obtained.
- A drain cover is missing at the top of Matheson Lane, noted by councillors.
- The dental petition was discussed, and concern expressed about the loss of NHS dentistry provision.
