10. Roads Issues

- a. Lights at Toward Primary: Solar panel not facing in the right direction.

 - c. War Memorial: major improvements are still required although it was tidied up before Remembrance Sunday. Light still not working.

11. Sewage Issues at Toward: MB updated the meeting, saying Scottish Water refused to carry out any works.
